

Rules & Regulations

The Essentials

We are a club, a community of equals where all are willing to support and learn from their peers. All activities and interactions are expected to be within this spirit in a welcoming, safe and trusted environment. We welcome all members who are, or wish to be, Pluralists and can contribute to the life of the Club.

While overt selling is discouraged, it is not uncommon for our members to uncover business opportunities from their fellow members, which may be pursued and discussed in an appropriate manner.

The Chatham House Rule applies to all member events.

Terms and Conditions

1. Definitions

1.1 "MEMBER" means the person who is named on The Pluralists Club Application for Membership form and for whom, following acceptance by The Pluralists Club ('the Club'), the Club has agreed to provide services to.

1.2 "MEMBERSHIP" means the period of time when a Member is contracted to the Club.

1.3 "SPECIFIED SERVICE" means the service provided by the Club as described in the literature provided with these terms.

1.4 "CLUB" means The Pluralists Club which is owned and operated by TMRM Ltd, 107 North Street, Martock, TA12 6EJ.

1.5 "PAYMENTS" means the payments due to the Club at agreed intervals throughout the Contract Term and until the agreement is terminated by either party in accordance with these terms.

1.6 "INITIAL CONTRACT TERM" means the initial 12 month period from the date when the Member signs the Application for Membership form.

1.7 "RENEWAL TERM" means membership periods of 12 months following the Initial Contract Term.

2. Agreement to these Terms

When applying for membership of the Club, the Member confirms that he/she has read and agrees with these Terms and Conditions. A copy of the Terms and Conditions should be kept by the Member for future reference.

The Directors of the Club reserve the right to revise the Terms and Conditions at any time to ensure regulatory compliance and best practice. An up to date version of the Terms and Conditions will always be available on the website www.thepluralists.club

3. Supply of the Specified Service

3.1 The Club will provide the Specified Service to the Member subject to these terms.

3.2 The Club will make every effort to provide the Specified Service at the advertised times.

3.3 Where it proves necessary, the Club may at any time without notifying the Member make any changes to the Specified Service.

3.4 Any other changes or additions to the Specified Service will be notified to the Member in writing or by e-mail by the Club in advance of those changes taking place.

4. Contract Term and Payments

4.1 Membership of the Club is for an Initial Contract Term of 12 months from the date of signing the application form or confirming your application online. The membership fee (plus VAT) is payable either in its entirety in advance or by 12 Monthly Payments by direct debit, as set out in the literature provided with these terms. The Member will receive invoices in respect of these payments.

4.2 Following the expiry of the Initial Contract Term, membership and payments will continue for further periods of twelve months - the Renewal Term - until either party terminates in accordance with these Terms.

4.3 All charges quoted to the Member for the provision of the Specified Service are exclusive of VAT at the prevailing rate unless otherwise indicated.

4.4 Should a Monthly Payment be late or remain unpaid during the Contract Term, the remaining Monthly Payments up to the end of the Contract Term will be due immediately, plus interest at a rate of 5%, and the Club will suspend the Specified Service until outstanding payments have been made.

4.5 If overdue Monthly Payments are not received within 14 days of the Club requesting them, debt collection proceedings will be commenced and any fees incurred charged to the Member.

5. Warranties and Liability

5.1 The Club will provide the Specified Service using reasonable care and skill as far as is practically possible. From time to time the Club will use the services of a third party (such as speakers at events). The Club will use its best endeavours to ensure that these third parties are suitable for the particular event and audience.

5.2 The Club shall not be liable to the Member (unless fraudulent or negligent) for any loss of profit or any indirect, special or consequential loss, damage costs, expenses or other claims (whether caused by the negligence of the Club or its agents or otherwise) which arise out of or in connection with the provision of the Specified Service.

5.3 The Club shall not be liable to the Member or be deemed to be in breach of these Terms for any delay in performing, or any failure to perform, any of the Club's obligations in relation to the Specified Service, if the delay or failure is due to any cause beyond the Club's reasonable control.

6. Termination of Membership or Course Bookings

6.1 All memberships are for an Initial Contract Term. For The Pluralists Club membership this is twelve calendar months. For the Portfolio Life MBA this is for three calendar months.

The Member may terminate their membership by giving 1 month's written notice to the Club prior to the end of the Initial Contract Term and, in the case of Club membership, the Renewal Term.

6.2 Either party may at any time terminate the contract by immediate written notice if the other commits any material breach of these terms or goes into liquidation, becomes bankrupt, makes a voluntary arrangement with its creditors or has a receiver or administrator appointed.

6.3 Upon termination of this contract for whatever reason all sums owed by the Member to the Club are due and payable by the Member with immediate effect.

7. Membership - Initial Contract Term Guarantee

7.1 The Club wishes for members to receive a return on their investment many times over through full involvement in the Specified Services, however, the Member retains responsibility for making the very most of the many opportunities membership offers. If the Member does not make use of the services offered under membership during the Term, The Club accepts no liability and no refund will be offered.

7.2 During the first 12 weeks of the Initial Contract Term should a Member feel they have not received value for money, they may cancel their membership without further payment of membership fees and receive a full refund of all fees paid.

7.3 If a member has not cancelled their membership within the first 12 week period. The annual membership will be deemed agreed and no refund will be available.

8. Membership Renewal

8.1 Your Membership will automatically be renewed at the appropriate charge if you do not cancel.

8.2 If you wish to cancel your membership, please let us know in writing to the address set out in paragraph 1.4 or by email to members@thepluralists.club within TWO weeks of receiving your renewal notice. We will then cancel your payments and do all other paperwork.

9. Privacy and Data Protection

9.1 For the purposes of the Data Protection Act 1998 (the Act), the data controller is TMRM Ltd of 107 North Street, Martock, Somerset

9.2 We may collect and process the following information from you:

9.2.1 information that you provide by filling in forms on our website www.thepluralists.club (our Website);

9.2.2 if you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence; and

9.2.3 details of your visits to our Website and the resources that you access.

9.3 We use information held about you in the following ways:

9.3.1 to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us;

9.3.2 to provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes;

9.3.3 to ensure that content from our Website is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer; and

9.3.4 to notify you about changes to our service.

9.4 We may also use your data, or permit selected third parties to use your data, to provide you with information about goods and services which may be of interest to you and we or they may contact you about these. If you do not want us to use your data in this way, or to pass your details on to third parties for marketing purposes, please tick the relevant box situated on the form on which we collect your data.

9.5 Disclosure of information

9.5.1 We may disclose your personal information to any member of our group, which means our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries, as defined in section 1159 of the United Kingdom Companies Act 2006.

9.5.2 We may disclose your personal information to: our affiliates or professional advisers; persons or organisations who work on our behalf to provide a product or a service to you; companies which perform marketing services on our behalf or with whom we have joint marketing agreements; and other companies who we believe may have products and services of interest to you unless you have told us otherwise.

9.5.3 We may also disclose your personal information to third parties if: we sell or buy any business assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets; TMRM Ltd or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by us about our customers will be one of the transferred assets; we

are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms of use and other agreements, or to protect the rights, property or safety of TMRM Ltd, our customers or others, including exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

9.7 How we protect your data

9.7.1 The data that we collect from you may be transferred to and stored at a destination outside the European Economic Area (EEA). It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for us or for one of our suppliers. Such staff may be engaged in, among other things, the fulfilment of contracts, the processing of details or the provision of support services. By submitting your personal data you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Cookies and Privacy Policy.

9.7.2 Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our Website. Any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

9.7.3 We take all reasonable care to ensure the security of the website and of your personal information from access by unauthorised persons and against unlawful processing, accidental loss, destruction and damage. We will not share your information other than as provided for in this Cookies and Privacy Policy or as required by law, court order or other government or law enforcement authorities.

9.8 IP addresses and cookies

9.8.1 We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration purposes.

9.8.2 Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. Cookies allow a web application to tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

9.8.3 This statistical data does not identify an individual. We only use this information: to gather information on IP addresses and pages visited; to analyse trends; to administer the website; to track users' movements on the website; and for purposes of statistical analysis.

9.8.4 You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of our Website. Unless you have adjusted your browser settings so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you log on to our Website.

9.9. Links to other websites

9.9.1 This Cookies and Privacy Policy extends only to our Website and does not cover your use of, provision of data to and collection of data on any other website.

9.9.2 Our Website may from time to time contain links to and from other websites. If you follow a link to any of these websites please note that these websites have their own privacy policies and that we do not accept any responsibility or liability for these policies. You should always check these policies before you submit any personal data to these websites.

9.10. Changes to this privacy policy

9.10.1 Our Cookies and Privacy Policy may be reviewed and enhanced from time to time. The up-to-date version of our Privacy Policy is always available by applying in writing to TMRM Ltd, 107 North Street, Martock; or by emailing enquiries@thepluralists.club. It may be necessary to contact you and obtain your consent regarding any significant changes to our Privacy Policy.

9.11. Your right to access information

9.11.1 The Act gives you the right to obtain a copy of the personal data we hold about you. The fee for obtaining a copy of your information is £10 which will go towards meeting our costs in providing you with details of the information we hold about you. We can provide you with that information further to a request in writing to TMRM Ltd, 107 North Street, Martock, TA12 6EJ providing us with sufficient information to identify you (we may need to request proof of identity in some instances). You have the right to request an amendment to any information that we hold and which you believe to be incorrect.

10.2 If any provision of these Terms is held by any court or other competent authority to be invalid or unenforceable in whole or in part, the validity of the other provisions of these Terms and the remainder of the provision in question shall not be affected.

10.3 English law shall apply to this agreement, and the parties agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the English courts.

10.4 Membership of the Club is personal to each Member and can not be transferred.

10.5 Membership allows a Member to access private areas of the Club's website and online network. This access will continue whilst payments are up to date. Should payments lapse, access may be suspended. If a Member should decide to cancel their Membership, access will stop from the end of the notice period.

10.6 The Club understands that e-mail marketing is a useful tool, however, members are asked to keep email marketing to other members to a minimum and to include an 'opt-out' facility on every email. The Club reserves the right to suspend the Member's access to the private network in the event of complaints.

10.7 Members agree to conduct themselves in a professional and business-like manner, treating other members with respect at all times. If the Club should receive a complaint about any Member's behaviour, it reserves the right to suspend membership. Being the subject of such complaints may constitute a breach of these terms.

10.8 Membership of the Club is at the sole discretion of the Club and it reserves the right to refuse membership.
